APPLICATION PROPOSAL

You may choose to write, videotape, or tape record your responses. Please make your responses your own, although feel free to ask an adult for help if you need it in thinking through or communicating your answers.

INTRODUCTION: Introduce yourself in a paragraph or two. Who are you? What are your greatest interests? What are your strengths/talents?

NEEDS AS A LEARNER: How do you learn best? What aspects of MC² do you believe will help you be a successful learner? What classes have you been most successful in?

ADDRESS THESE QUESTIONS:

- If the coming year in high school were to be perfect for you both educationally and personally, what would have happened?
- Why do you believe having your parent(s) more involved in your education would be helpful?
- If you could learn anything you wanted, what would you want to learn about?

ADDITIONAL ITEMS REQUIRED:

1. A statement from your parent(s)/guardian(s) answering the question: "Why I am interested in having my child attend MC²?"
2. A letter of reference from a teacher (in school or out of school) or guidance counselor who knows you well.
3. A copy of the most recent report card or Powerschool printout

You will need to participate on a one-day learning experience that will provide you with an opportunity to learn about the MC² program.

Following completion of your application, you and your parent(s)/guardian(s) will meet with the MC² School Leader for an interview.
